YOUNG musicians made the most of a newly re-opened cultural quarter by performing hip hop, funk and reggae tunes they had written themselves.

Pupils from Brighton and Hove primary

schools played on African drums, keyboards and guitars in New Road as part of a city-wide Soundmakers scheme which aims to give every child he chance to make music. The event was organised

by Brighton and Hove Music Trust and involved budding rock and pop stars from Goldstone Primary School in Hove, Peter Gladwin Primary School in Portslade and Fairlight Primary
